**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2018**

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Mole Street (D290), Ockley that extends from its junction with Ockley Road (B2126) to its junction with Pisle Lane (D291). This Traffic Order is required to enable A-Plant LUX/BT Openreach to carry out excavations and cabling works. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30 within one week of the three month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 9th April 2018. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. The diversion route for vehicular traffic will be via Ockley Road, Stane Street and Cathill Lane.
