- Details of the *Refill Mole Valley scheme* are to be circulated to some businesses in the area. This is a scheme to fight plastic pollution. People who are looking for water can refill their water bottles for free if businesses have joined up to the scheme. Encouraging people to drink tap water rather than buying bottled water reduces single use plastic waste at source. Anyone can download a free app to find 'refill stations' near to them. Participating businesses put a sticker in their window to tell people that they're welcome to go in and get their bottle refilled.
- Dorking and Leatherhead Community Recycling Centres are to remain open.
