1. Minutes of meeting held on 4 May 2021

Further information was given to the parishioner regarding the Community Hub / Ockley School buildings. Legal hurdles could take time to overcome – initially (1800's) a Trust was set up to provide education for the poor children of Ockley. This would not cover plans for the buildings in the future. A section 554 agreement from the Secretary of State would allow the objectives of the Trust to be changed – so that the residents of Ockley could benefit from the use of the buildings, not just the poor children needing education. The Diocese at Guildford is involved and has asked for a business plan which is being prepared. Grant funding will be required (Your Fund Surrey). HC stated that core funding can be obtained for professional fees. HC to contact The Diocese to enquire whether a different approach could be made so that matters could move forward.
